IPAMS to Testify Before House Natural Resources Committee on Harmful Effects of 'CLEAR Act' to American Natural Gas Supply

(DENVER) – Independent Petroleum Association of Mountain States (IPAMS) Board member Alex Campbell, Vice President of Land, Enduring Resources, will testify before the House Natural Resources Committee on Thursday, September 17, 2009. Mr. Campbell will speak to the adverse effects that H.R. 3534, the *Consolidated Land Energy and Aquatic Resources Act of 2009* (CLEAR Act) would have on America's supply of natural gas. Independent producers in the Intermountain West such as Enduring supply 27% of America's natural gas, much of it from reserves on non-park, non-wilderness public lands. IPAMS estimates that the CLEAR Act would put at risk about 15% of America's natural gas supply.

Mr. Campbell is Vice President of Enduring Resources, an independent Western energy producer with 19 employees. Enduring Resources operates on public lands in the West, and was one of the companies whose leases were withdrawn by Interior Secretary Ken Salazar earlier this year.
