

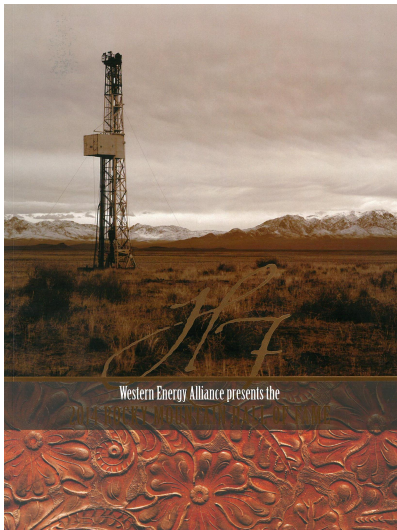
## **Rocky Mountain Hall of Fame** <sup>[1]</sup>
